**PUSH CART DERBY RULES**

**SAFETY:**

**Every driver must wear the following:**

- Helmet (bicycle or motorcycle) –each racer must have their own
- Gloves – each racer must have their own – must be worn for every race pushing and driving

**NO GLOVES = NO RACE**

- Pants/Jeans – **NO SHORTS!!**
- Closed-toed shoes – required –**NO SANDALS!**
- Knee and elbow – optional, but recommended
- Long sleeve shirt – optional, but recommended

**Carts must be equipped with the following safety items:**

- Seat Belt – must be safe and must fit the race appropriately – **not supplied in the kit**
- Brake
- Steering Stops (limiter) – **set to specification as outlined in the kit instructions**
- Push bar

**OPERATION DURING DERBY EVENT:**

- Use your legs to steer the cart
- Use the hand brake to slow down or stop the cart. **DO NOT USE YOUR FEET**
- Pusher cannot push the cart beyond the set line at the top of the hill
- The winner is determined by the Finish Line Judge
- After crossing the finish line, grab the hand brake at the marked braking line and clear the course **BEFORE** removing safety gear (gloves, helmet, seat belt, etc.)
- Parent or guardian must be present for duration of the event
- **Any unsportsmanlike conduct by a scout, a parent or guest will result in complete removal from the race and the event. All scouts, families and guests must act accordingly.**

**CART SPECIFICATIONS:**

- Must use Pushcart Derby kit produced by Boy Scout Troop 1103 **in entirety per assembly manual**
- Do not add weights of any kind
- Must use wheels supplied in kit – No bearings allowed
- Wheel collars can be lubricated – No modification to axles
- Any modification that can render the cart unsafe will not be allowed
- Personalization such as: seat pads/covers, painting, decals, and reflectors allowed as long as they meet safety standards
- Cardboard number plates, covers, panels, fairing are allowed as long as they are secured safely
- After Tech check-in there can be **NO** alterations made or the car will be disqualified
